

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:05 P.M. by Clerk Crosby. Members present: Andersen, Brown, Crosby, Davis, Krygier and Porter. Members absent: McIntyre. Also present: five spectators. Motion by Crosby, Brown supported, to appoint Porter as chair. CARRIED.
2. Public Comment: Mark Jansen, candidate for State Senate, introduced himself.
3. Motion by Andersen, Krygier supported, to approve the agenda. CARRIED.
4. Consent Agenda: Motion by Krygier, Brown supported, to approve the Consent Agenda. CARRIED.
 - A. Approval of Minutes – April 5, 2006 Regular Board meeting.
 - B. Treasurer's Report /Approval of bills for payment – General Fund, Sewer, and Fire Department. Treasurer Jerry Davis stated that he had invested in CD's at Greenville Community Bank and Byron Center Bank.
5. Supervisor's Report/Building Permits/Correspondence: Building permits were issued in April for five new residences @ \$634,000.00, bringing the 2006 total to 15 homes. Last year 39 permits had been issued during the same period. Upcoming meetings: NKSA meeting on May 4 at City of Rockford. Deputy Supervisor Don Shaw reported that complaints were up now that spring is here.
6. Fire Board Report: Chief Mickey Davis reported that there were 25 runs for April. The new truck has arrived and will soon be outfitted for fighting grass fires. The old (1979) grass rig is up for sale and bids will be taken through May 30.
7. Zoning Board of Appeals Report: Andersen reported that the Matzen (Crinnion Ave.) setback variance, which had been tabled in March, was approved. One request was received for May.
8. Planning Commission Report: Jerry Davis reported that no regular meeting was held, but a Master Plan work session was held on April 20 and another work session will be held on May 23.
9. Resolution 2006-12 Declaring May 7-13, 2006 as Chemical Awareness Week. Motion by Krygier, Davis supported, to adopt Resolution 2006-12 Declaring May 7-13, 2006 as Chemical Awareness Week. POLLED VOTE: YES – ALL.
10. PDR Applications: One application for 2006-07 Purchase of Development Rights was received from Max Cole of 8063 Benham St. Motion by Davis, Krygier supported, to approve the PDR application from Max Cole for 2006-07. CARRIED.
11. Board Member Comments: Brown reported that the Cedar Springs Parks and Recreation Committee will be holding several fundraisers in the near future, and that they appreciate our support. Andersen gave a brief update on Supervisor McIntyre's health. Crosby reported a less than 6% turnout for the May 2nd election. This was the first election using the township's three new precincts.

As there was no further business to be considered, the meeting was adjourned at 7:55 P.M.
